

# Blow Me Over

## Materials

6 to 10 sheets of construction paper in different colors

Scissors

## Preparation

Cut the construction paper in 2 x 5½-inch strips. Fold the strips across the 5½-inch length and stand them in a row.

## Playing the Game

This simple activity lends itself to many games.

Ask the children to blow down the papers.

See who can blow the most papers over with one breath.

Alternate colors, and ask the children to direct their air stream carefully to blow over only one color and not the others.

Line the papers in a row and blow them down like dominoes.

Vary the paper sizes.

Paper strip tents low to the floor will be harder to topple, but they can scoot! Race the papers.
